## Devotional Guide

### A prayer for refuge

**Scripture Reading: Psalm 142**

**Monday: Read Psalm 142: 1 - 3**

This psalm, a lament, stems from an individual, falsely accused and under dark confinement; prisons as known today did not exist. The composer borrowed freely from other laments - (*Psalms 16 and 22*). The structure is typical: a call for God's attention, a lament and a prayer for help. The title associates the psalm with David's hiding from Saul in a cave, certainly an encouragement for anyone under persecution who, like David, is assured Jehovah's special care.

**Tuesday: Read Psalm 142: 4 - 6**

Consolation is found in memorized prayers. The psalm literally speaks of pouring out "my meditations," my continuous mumbling of prayers. The psalmist challenges the Lord: "Look carefully to the right (where a friend ought to be) and see; there is no one willing to acknowledge me. Verse 6 accumulates familiar phrases, especially drawn from the Levites but here applied to all Israel, which recognizes a personal consecration to the Lord.

**Wednesday: Read Psalm 142: 7**

Have you ever felt that no one cared what happened to you? David had reason to feel that way, and he wrote, "Hear my cry, for I am very low." Through prayer we can pull out of our tailspin and be reminded that God cares for us deeply.

**Thursday & Friday: Read Psalm 142**

"I cry out to the Lord; I plead for the Lord's mercy.

I pour out my complaints before him and tell him all my troubles.

For I am overwhelmed, and you alone know the way I should turn.

Wherever I go, my enemies have set traps for me.

I look for someone to come and help me, but no one gives me a passing thought!

No one will help me; no one cares a bit what happens for me.

Then I pray to you, O Lord."

I say, "You are my place of refuge. You are all I really want in life. Hear my cry, for I am very low. Rescue me from my persecutors, for they are too strong for me. Bring me out of prison so I can thank you. The godly will crowd around me, for you treat me kindly."
