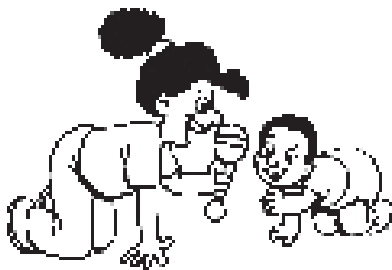
OTHER NEWS
