down the path of peace.."

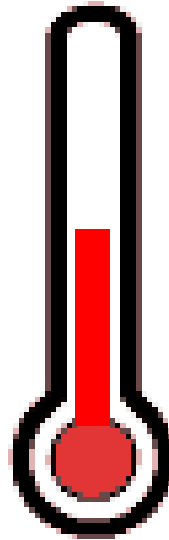
